

The Bradley Central High School track and field team will be traveling to Atlanta, GA this weekend for the Coaches Classic at Georgia Tech. Following is a list of information that is important for you to know:

Departure: All athletes will need to be at the gym at Bradley by 9:30 Thursday, March 18. We will leave at 10:00. Please have your child to the school on time so that we can leave promptly at 10:00.

Hotel: We will be staying at the Embassy Suites Galleria in Atlanta. The address for the hotel is 2815 Akers Mill Road. The phone number for the hotel is 770-984-9300.

Meet Information: The meet will take place at Griffin Stadium on the campus of Georgia Tech University. Friday the meet will begin at 5:30 pm and end at approximately 9:30 pm. Saturday the meet will begin at 10:00 am and end at approximately 4:00 pm.

Money: Your child has already raised the money that they will need for transportation and hotel costs. The meet entry is also taken care of. The money that you will need to send with your child will be money for food and other items that your child wishes to buy. Your child will need money for approximately 6 meals (lunch and dinner for three days). Breakfast will be provided at the hotel. Any other money you send for t-shirts at the meet, etc. is up to you.

Arrival: After the meet we will stop at Dave and Busters (which is a restaurant and arcade) in Atlanta for dinner. When everyone has finished eating/playing we will depart for home. An estimated arrival time is around 11:00 pm. We will have your child call you when we get close to Cleveland.

Behavior: As always, your child is expected to behave in a way that positively reflects them, their family, and their school. Even though we do not expect any problems to arise, if they do, they will be dealt with accordingly.
